Nomination Deadline	May 31 st (for 1 st semester students)
	October 30 th (for 2 nd semester students)
	After the nomination, students will receive an access code to start the online application form. (Students do not have to register on "Segreteria online" before receiving the access code)
Application Form	After completing the application form exchange students will receive an acceptance mail and practical information.
	The Welcome Office will send a digital acceptance letter to non EU students. Students have to apply for a study visa at the Italian consulate with this letter
